

Lecture cancelation policy in the event of an emergency

We have established this policy on lecture cancelation below to use in the event of an emergency such as a natural disaster or suspension of public transportation.

Although this policy will be the general standard, professors assigned to give the lectures can decide whether their lectures will be cancelled or not by discussing the matter with his or her students.

1. In the event of weather warnings such as warning of heavy rain, flood, storm, heavy snow or snow storm in the Chiyoda ward
 - For active alerts at 6am: 1st and 2nd period lectures will be canceled
 - For active alerts at 10am: 3rd and 4th period lectures will be canceled
 - For active alerts at noon: Lectures through 3rd and 6th period will be canceled

2. In the event of major public transportation suspensions of the JR lines and private lines such as subways.
 - For active suspensions at 6am: 1st and 2nd period lectures will be canceled
 - For active suspensions at 10am: 3rd and 4th period lectures will be canceled
 - For active suspensions at noon: Lectures through 3rd and 6th period will be canceled
