- Research and operations
 - Bibliographic utility
 - International scholarly communication initiative
 - Network operations
 - :

What is NII-IRP?

- NII-IRP: NII Institutional Repository Portal
 - Not a portal site name, but an advocacy activity
 - NII-IRP Project 2004
 - Jun 2004 – Mar 2005
 - To implement DSpace and GNU EPrints
 - CJK compatibility
 - OAI-PMH linking to centralized metadata repository at NII

 - Tokyo

 - Chiba

 - 2 released (“InfoLib” and “E-repository”)
 - other 2 planned (by USACO Corp. and Fujitsu Corp.)

Contents policy

“JuNii”

- Centralized metadata repository
- OAI-PMH compliant
 - has Harvester
 - To harvest metadata from universities
 - behaves as an OAI-PMH repository
 - To disseminate metadata to other service providers
- Any networked academic resources
 - Institutional repositories
 - Digital library systems (rare books, maps, photos,...)
 - Surface web resources in Japan (mainly, manually cataloged by librarians)

JuNii as a service provider

- <http://ju.nii.ac.jp/>
- search
 - metadata
 - full text cached from Institutional repositories (planned)
- browse
 - by resource genre (NII original dc.type vocabulary)
 - research output
 - learning objects
 - library materials
 - :
 - by controlled subject (planned)

JuNii as a data provider

- disseminate metadata via OAI-PMH
 - NII original application profile for academic resources in Japan (extended from DublinCore)
 - Simple DublinCore
- convert Japanese character into ASCII when harvested
 - limited to dc.title, dc.creator, dc.publisher, dc.contributor
 - “Creator: 土屋, 俊 (ツチヤ, シュン)” in JuNii
“<dc.creator>Tsuchiya, Shun</dc.creator>” in OAI-PMH
