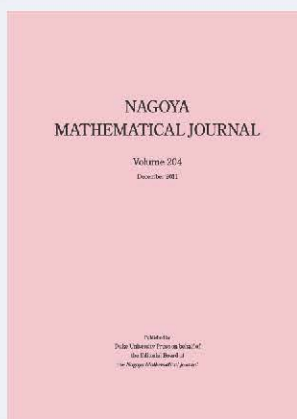
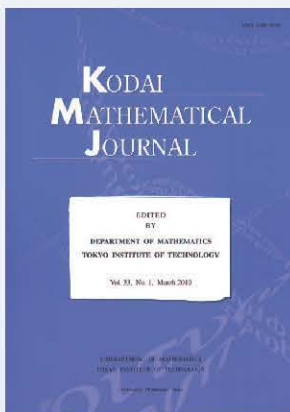

The project was launched in 2003 through support by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, and it encourages digitization of scholarly journals, especially English language journals published in Japan with SPARC Japan Publishing Partners. The aim is to create a self-sustaining cost-recovery model that will enable stable transmission of Japanese scholarly journals and improve their name recognition overseas.

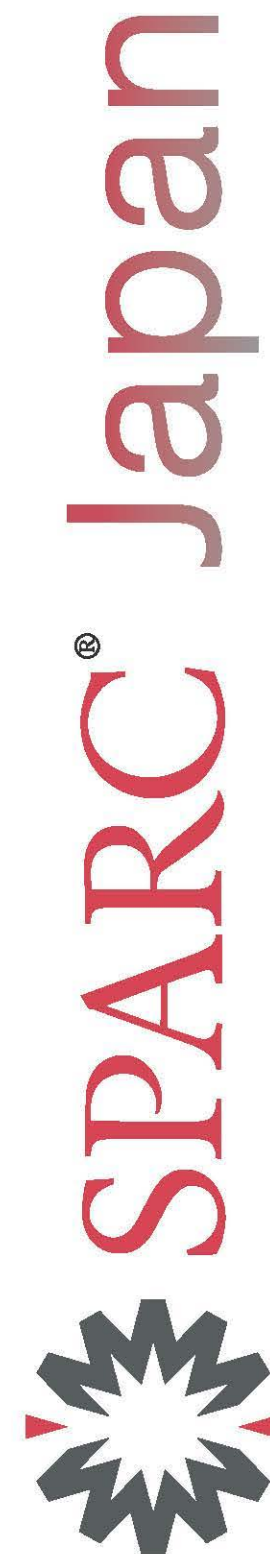

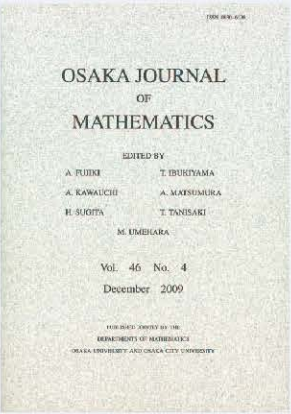


Osaka Journal of Mathematics

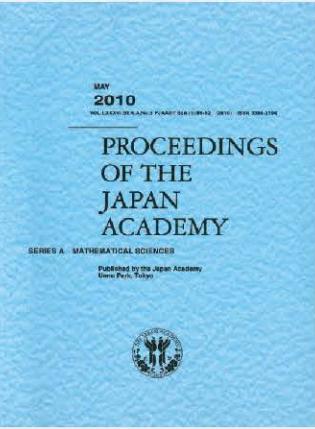


Proceedings of the Japan Academy, Series A: Mathematical Sciences

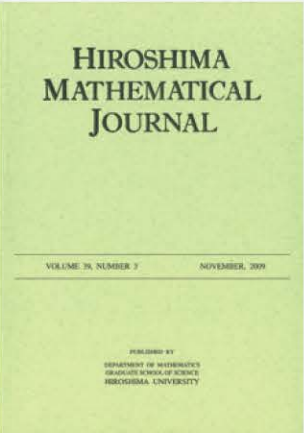


Hiroshima Mathematical Journal

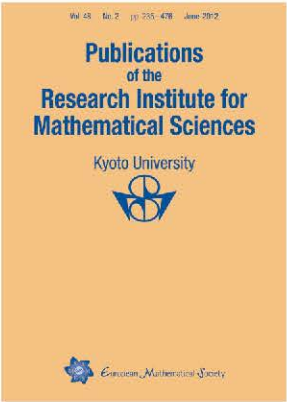


Publications of the Research Institute for Mathematical Sciences
